EPISODE SIX - "RETURN"

INT. NEWS STUDIO

In the studio.

APOORVA SINGH

Nautalon, Guardian of the Sea has responded to President Norris's request for assistance in enforcing the UN's embargo on Isla Silva. Nautalon said that the Deep Seas are happy to help, quote "as soon as land-kind stops throwing plastic in the ocean." Until then they will not take sides.

UNDERWRITER That was Apoorva Singh reporting from SPR Honolulu.

WENLING CHEN Live from SPR News in Washington, I'm Wenling Chen. (then) President Norris called a press conference this morning to address the latest clash between Superhuman Rights group, Incognito, and Unpowered-Pride organization, Normcore, that left 15 injured in Boston.

INT. PRESS HALL

SFX: Press Walla. Cameras snapping.

PRESIDENT NORRIS That was a tragic, tragic day. There's no denying that now tensions between people and supers are out of control.

REPORTER #1, NEWS 1, EP 6 What about Normcore's involvement? Will you denounce them now?

PRESIDENT NORRIS You have to admit they are somewhat outmatched. (MORE) PRESIDENT NORRIS (CONT'D) So you have one group that was violent, but the group on the other side was just as violent. I do not think anyone was perfectly in the right.

(then)

I do believe that both groups have been the victims of outside influence.

(then)

The Doppelgänger known as Cosmos has increased tensions between our people. However fighting fire with fire destroys the whole woods. For the sake of our nation, it is our duty to cool this anger before we are consumed by it.

(then)

That is why I have decided that we are going to resume diplomatic relations with the Island Xen, effective immediately. We have more in common than divides us and the people of Xen should be our allies against this Doppelgänger threat, not our adversaries.

REPORTER CHORUS, NEWS 1, EP 6 Mr. President! Mr. President!

WENLING CHEN

Secretary Munzie has since signaled that the State Department will normalize relations if the Island agrees to help reign in vigilantes who have found refuge on the island and to surrender Galetea back to Tzarpathia. Xen has no official diplomat, but all eyes are looking to Cosmos for his response.

UNDERWRITER

That was Wenling Chen reporting from Washington, it's 74 degrees here in Paradise City. And now These American Supers...

EPISODE SIX - ACT ONE - TAS 24HRS AT THE SILVER DINER

INT. DINER

SFX: Diner walla. Cutlery. Robots.

ETHAN SCHWARTZ From QSPZ Baltimore, it's These American Supers, I'm Ethan Schwartz.

BUSTER BOLT ...She's holding him over the ledge. And then I say to her: "let him go."

NEUTRINO Poor choice of words.

BUSTER BOLT I know! It just came out!

NEUTRINO How come you never tee me up like that?

BUSTER BOLT Maybe I do, but you aren't... Quick enough?

The pair laugh.

ETHAN SCHWARTZ

For people like Buster Bolt and his nemesis, Neutrino, there exists a singular place, where can they hang up the cape, and come together as friends.

NEUTRINO So she drops him?

BUSTER BOLT

Like a bag a bricks. I'm thinking great, I just got my suit waxed and now it's going to get all scuffed again. So I jump off after him...

LOIS Order up! I got two fastball specials and a dark knight. For this episode, Producer Hailey Frond spends twenty four hours inside to bring you the secrets of this strange urban sanctuary...

HAILEY FROND Tucked into an empty lot at the three way intersection on Gray Lane, you may have caught the mirage-like shimmer of a crashed UFO. Converted to a greasy spoon in the 1950's, this is the Silver Saucer.

Note: Neutrino, speaks with a strong Chicago accent. Her dialogue should have a tinge as if the mic got near a magnet.

NEUTRINO Best coffee in the universe.

HAILEY FROND They would know. Buster Bolt and Neutrino have fought on each other on every planet in the Solar system.

BUSTER BOLT Well not Mercury.

NEUTRINO

Too hot.

BUSTER BOLT Way too hot.

HAILEY FROND But at the saucer, they make time to sit down together, once a week in the corner booth. (then) There's even a photo of them above it to mark the spot.

BUSTER BOLT Beatsa meeting on a rooftop.

NEUTRINO

Too windy.

SERVEBOT Hot stuff coming in.

HAILEY FROND

A banged-up android with its pleasantries dialed up to 11 drops off platefuls of eggs, bacon and hash-browns.

SERVEBOT

Adam and Eve on a Raft, and wreck'em. Two dots and a dash with a side of sweepings, I'll be back with a refill on your high and dry.

NEUTRINO We always split the hash-browns.

HAILEY FROND You two are famous nemeses, weren't your mothers...

BUSTER BOLT Mortal enemies? NEUTRINO Mortal enemies?

NEUTRINO (CONT'D) Yeah. We're just carrying on the tradition.

BUSTER BOLT They still send snakes to each other on holidays.

They laugh.

HAILEY FROND And you're about to share a plate of home fries?

NEUTRINO

And bacon... (adding) Hand it over.

BUSTER BOLT Look, life is short. You, know? We could get hit by an asteroid...

NEUTRINO In fifteen hours...And 23 minutes. BUSTER BOLT Wait really? Aw, you!

They laugh.

HAILEY FROND

This surreal breakfast, would feel out of place anywhere else. But here, it's all according to the master plan of the owner, Lois Everest.

Note: Lois sounds like Joan Rivers. We can hear bubbles at the end of all her sentences.

LOIS

Hey Servebot, table five's asking for a refill on, ugh, why bother...

HAILEY FROND

It would be easy to mistake Lois as part of the décor. She's little more than a bubblegum-pink coil of brain matter in a shining glass tube.

HAILEY FROND (CONT'D) How can you account --

LOIS

I swear to god! I will replace you with a Roomba! Go on dear...

HAILEY FROND

How have you made the Silver Saucer into such a safe space? And what's up with these floating pie cases?

LOIS The cases originally housed torpedoes, but now they show off our real weapons. (then) It's all part of the magic. You cross a threshold and you see pie, what's there to fight about? I'm partial to the cheesecake myself.

HAILEY FROND How do you [eat]... It's an amazing accomplishment given... LOIS ...That I was melted down to the grey matter? This place isn't about being stuck in the past. If it were, I'd be flying through space looking for justice instead of slinging grits in Baltimore. (then) I honestly think I've done more good here. (then) If I have fannies [ALT: Spandex] in my booths, that saves a building

somewhere from getting smashed to pieces. (then)

Plus, it's a robot rehab. All the servers have been refurbished, reprogrammed, and spared from the scrap heap.

SERVEBOT

Hockey puck with a rose on it, hot blond with sand and a houseboat in the alley!

LOIS That's classic diner lingo, it's the only language they know. I find it charming

(then (yelling)) Servebot I found you in a dump and I can put you back there if you don't hurry up with that coffee!

HAILEY FROND Besides the great cheesecake, according to Buster Bolt, the diner serves a deeper need.

BUSTER BOLT It's like the villains always say" We're not so different you and I..."

HAILEY FROND For these two, it seems hard to find people who get you the way your nemesis does.

BUSTER BOLT You punch someone for twenty years, you to get to know them. (MORE)

BUSTER BOLT (CONT'D)

I've told Neutrino stuff I haven't told my wife.

NEUTRINO

Sometimes you're hoping to get caught, just so you can catch up. Then the B lister shows up and you're stuck fighting some yokel instead of chatting. It's exhausting.

BUSTER BOLT

Sure when you start its all, "you'll never get away with this Neutrino!" But a couple years in it's: "You'll never get away with this Neutrino! Also, how was your kid's bar mitzvah?"

SERVEBOT

One big mug of Joe drawn in the dark.

LOIS

Thank you!

HAILEY FROND Servebot takes the coffee to a large group whose laughter has been growing since I arrived here. (then) See, the diner isn't just a clubhouse for frenemies, but a home base for folks on either side of the eternal struggle.

Group laughter.

HAILEY FROND (CONT'D) The sextuplet is made up heroes and villains who clearly need medical attention: Torn spandex, bloody scrapes, bright smiles. (then)

They're so engrossed in their conversation, they hardly notice Servebot refilling them.

LADY CRIME, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Oh, and then I'm being so careful to pick up all the diamonds you just spilled everywhere... CANADIAN BACON MAN, S. SAUCER, EP 6 And then Grongo here throws me through the store's window...

LADY CRIME, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Getting shards mixed all through my little diamond recovery project...

BANDITA, S. SAUCER, EP 6 That's going to be a headache to clean up in the morning. Speaking of, I think I have a concussion.

CANADIAN BACON MAN, S. SAUCER, EP 6 We really thought we had you this time.

LASER CHICK, S. SAUCER, EP 6 We do have them this time!

GRONGO, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Grongo!

Group laughter.

LASER CHICK, S. SAUCER, EP 6 (in tears) I can't, I can't! You all, save me a cup, I'm going to the little hero's room.

HAILEY FROND Can I ask what's so funny?

BANDITA, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Oh, just a heist gone wrong.

LADY CRIME, S. SAUCER, EP 6 And I almost got away with it, too!

HERO/VILLAIN GROUP, S. SAUCER, EP 6 (series for editing) No, you didn't !/Almost!/As If!

HAILEY FROND So you three robbed a jewelry store and you three tried to stop them?

CANADIAN BACON MAN, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Try**ing**.

BANDITA, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Does anyone else feel like they have a concussion? I feel like I have a concussion ... LADY CRIME, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Oh my nose is definitely broken! Your roundhouse kicks are improving! CATMANDO, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Thanks! Your "catlike reflexes" are truly living up to your ... (catching themselves) I mean... (whispering) You know what I mean! HAILEY FROND Tonight, you all were... CANADIAN BACON MAN, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Robbing --LADY CRIME, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Liberating the inventory of a jewelry store, until these bozos stepped in. CATMANDO, S. SAUCER, EP 6 But then they made a runner and --BANDITA, S. SAUCER, EP 6 We made it here. On base. GRONGO, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Grongo! LADY CRIME, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Safe. SFX: Diamonds Jingle. CANADIAN BACON MAN, S. SAUCER, EP 6 For now. LASER CHICK, S. SAUCER, EP 6 You'll have to leave eventually.

(then)

What I'd miss?

BANDITA, S. SAUCER, EP 6 You'll have to sleep eventually. (then) Oh here comes the cheesecake.

SERVEBOT One lady in a red dress.

CANADIAN BACON MAN, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Oh yeah it's got cherries on top.

GRONGO, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Grongo.

Group laughter. Oh's and ah's at the cheesecake. Clinking of silverware.

LASER CHICK, S. SAUCER, EP 6 Wow, that's a good cheesecake.

CATMANDO, S. SAUCER, EP 6 (yelling) Lois this is your best batch yet!

HAILEY FROND So, it sounds like you all are having a lot of... Fun together.

CANADIAN BACON MAN, S. SAUCER, EP 6

Does it?

Group laughter.

HAILEY FROND

The group stays on, ordering coffee well into the night, until one of the heroes goes out to feed the meter. Then the villains race through the back door. They leave a tip, which is generous, although it might end up exhibit A. They leave the Saucer feeling empty when they go, but throughout the night there's a steady stream of heroes and villains changing into coworkers and friends when they touch down outside. (then)

You can almost make out the spot in the parking lot where the magic of the saucer ends and real life begins.

(MORE)

HAILEY FROND (CONT'D)

But while you're inside her silver walls, there's nothing to worry about other than how you take your coffee, and what pie you're having this time.

(then) I suggest the cheesecake, it has cherries on top..

ETHAN SCHWARTZ That was producer Hailey Frond. (then) That's our show. A special thanks to Lois Everest for allowing the team access the diner for the day. You can see a special on the Silver Saucer this Thursday on Guy Fieri's Diners, Drive-ins and Dives. (then) I like to keep my team motivated by

I like to keep my team motivated by telling them.

LOIS

I swear to god! I will replace you with a Roomba!

ETHAN SCHWARTZ We'll be back with more These American Supers.

EPISODE SIX - END ACT ONE

INT. AD BREAK

In the studio.

ADS

Super for SPR comes from: Dr. Fungos. Are you tired of the endless cycle of villainy?

DR FUNGO'S AD VILLAIN It's a snake eating its own tail and I will unleash it on Miami as soon as I'm free! *cackling laughter*

ADS

At Dr. Fungo's Rehab Center for the Criminally Insane, we aim to treat the underlying causes of supervillainy, so you and your loved ones can enjoy a happier, less evil life. (then) Dr. Fungo's. Healing iniquity with dignity. (then) Use offer code: "cray-cray" for a five percent discount on your stay.

INT. NEWS STUDIO

In the studio.

WENLING CHEN Live from SPR News in Washington I'm Wenling Chen. (then) International retailer, Spandexo is facing a class action lawsuit that claims their new super suit line, Over Armor, has been making heroes mentally unstable. (then) CEO Jike Bindle refuted the claims in a press conference at Spandexo headquarters earlier this morning.

SFX: Press walla. Photos.

JIKE BINDLE

Spandexo is a family company and if there's any evidence of our suits causing harm to the supers and normals who wear them, I haven't seen it.

(then)

Obviously, Over Armor is the best selling product we've ever had, so there'll be some lawyers out there. Just *sniff* *sniff* sniffing out that payday. But we're not worried. We have the best gear on this or any world. I stand by it 100%. And a reminder to folks watching this press conference you can save 10% if you use the promo-code: "Innocence."

(then)

I will now take questions. You there in the front.

FIONA VAUGHAN

To follow up on your statement, there <u>are</u> several pieces of evidence supporting the claims of these heroes. Videos, eye witness statements, psychologist testimonies, all showing that wearers of Over Armor have been acting erratically.

(then)

So I have to ask, what is Spandexo hiding?

JIKE BINDLE

Hiding nothing! In fact, if anyone has questions, they're more than welcome to tour the plant itself. We're one big family, I'd rather folks join us instead of calling us names and being bullies.

FIONA VAUGHAN

Then why ignore FTC regulations regarding clothing labeling? (then) No one outside of your company, knows what these suits are made of.

JIKE BINDLE

If you want big government thinking for you, go for it. I think you need to do your own research. (MORE)

JIKE BINDLE (CONT'D)

Besides if Over Armor, was causing issues for these heroes, then our normal line of products would be causing them as well. They're made of the same darn thing.

FIONA VAUGHAN

Wait, so people using your regular super suits are at risk as well?

JIKE BINDLE

Risk? Only of style, comfort and protection. And possibly nosebleeds, don't wear them if pregnant.

FIONA VAUGHAN

[Mr. Bindle] What are these suits made of?

JIKE BINDLE

The future.

SFX: Jike leaves clipping the mic.

WENLING CHEN

Target has announced that they will be reviewing their relationship with the company pending a review.

UNDERWRITER

That was Wenling Chen reporting from Washington. It's 72 degrees here in Paradise City. And now a special Live episode of The Speech Bubble...

EPISODE SIX - END NEWS TWO

EXT. XEN

KELLY CLOSE Welcome to The Speech Bubble, I'm Kelly Close. (then) Ten years ago, Gen-Tec abandoned Isla Silva after their research facility was overrun by the same dinosaurs they were trying to market as a kid-friendly vacation attraction. (then) Plants slowly reclaimed the island as luxury suites became nests, tennis courts became hunting grounds and pools became watering holes.. (then) But here among the mega-flora and fauna, a new nation has formed. The locals call it Xen in tribute to their founder's homeworld, and for the first time since his high profile arrest last year, I get to meet him face to face. (then) Cosmos has been a controversial figure since he brought the first refugees to Xen. Today he wears a simple blue robe and loose, linen pants. How does it feel to be out of the spandex?

SFX: Puts shovel in dirt.

COSMOS

It makes gardening easier. It's good to see you again, Kelly. How was the trip?

KELLY CLOSE Little windy, but the company was excellent.

They share a private laugh.

KELLY CLOSE (CONT'D) It's been nearly a year since you first came here, can you tell us about those early days?

COSMOS

Well the refugees were on a flying cruise ship someone must've bought second hand. Almost six hundred of them, from all over the galaxy with nowhere to go. They were just drifting along running out of fuel, (ALT) and running out of time.

KELLY CLOSE

At the time you had been deported from America, labeled a "rogue" by the Heroic Legion. How did you learn about their situation?

COSMOS

I could hear them. I can hear everything. There's something like 15,000 licensed heroes in the world, but all of them had their hands tied by their governments. So I did the right thing. Being a "rogue" is unexpectedly liberating that way. The only rule you have to follow is: do the right thing

KELLY CLOSE

And why Isla Silva?

COSMOS

I had to put the boat down somewhere. Thanks to Gen-Tec's bankruptcy no one knew who owned it. Thanks to their experiments, no one wanted to live on it. And just look around.

KELLY CLOSE

It is gorgeous. Towering waterfalls, lush forests filled with tropical plants. Anything dangerous?

COSMOS

When we first landed, there were plenty of hazards. But we've come to an understanding with the natives. SFX: Not too distant roar.

COSMOS (CONT'D) Speaking of. No. No. Don't worry.

SFX: Roar. Big dinosaur steps.

GENUS

I know, I know, you big lummox, I'm getting it taken care of. I told you.

SFX: Roar.

COSMOS Trouble, Genus?

GENUS Just growing pains. These Daspletosaurs are so territorial. (then) Kelly! Good seeing you again.

KELLY CLOSE Genus, I didn't realize you were an (SFX ROAR) ...alien.

GENUS

No, no, homegrown, but Cosmos invited me out for a little R&R. Not sure if I'm getting either, but look at me! Talking to dinosaurs! There's a little lad inside me who's overjoyed. (then) Though the big lad in me has had it up to here with these feathery snakes. A couple of triceratops didn't get their habitat fixed quick enough, so they ate my hut. Ate it! Wonder I help any of these ingrates.

SFX: Roar.

GENUS (CONT'D) Yes, yes. And madam here, wants her own cave.

COSMOS

We'll see what we can carve out for her. Tell her she's looking fierce.

GENUS Doesn't need that filling up her head.

SFX: Distant roar.

GENUS (CONT'D)

Coming!

COSMOS We have a lot of environmental heroes coming here lately, apparently the outside world isn't so receptive to their message.

KELLY CLOSE You seem different. Calmer.

COSMOS

Life is easier. Instead of protecting the whole globe, I just need to look out for these 800 square miles. Besides the occasional volunteering.

KELLY CLOSE

That volunteering has ruffled some feathers, especially with President Norris. Who--

COSMOS Kelly, can we talk politics later?

KELLY CLOSE Oh alright. I think we were discussing the early days.

COSMOS

We got very lucky. Even though the world didn't seem to want these people, we have engineers, doctors, teachers, and probably the most supers per capita anywhere on Earth outside of Paradise City. (then) Everyone helps out. We have over 90

planets represented here, but I think their time on the Shooting Star helped erase some of those lines.

(then)

(MORE)

COSMOS (CONT'D)

We still have our squabbles, but overall I think people want Xen to be a sanctuary, so they try and make it one.

(then)

The hotels got renovated, farmland cultivated, we even have tech that would make Whiz Kid green. Let me show you the assembly room.

KELLY CLOSE

The assembly room used to be the park's planetarium, which screened features on the death of the dinosaurs and the miracle of Gen-Tec science. Now it's lined with neatly kept trees and marked by statues of... Is that one you?

COSMOS

Ha, yeah. I asked them not to. At least I got them to stop calling themselves: "The Cosmic".

KELLY CLOSE

World leaders typically depict you as some sort of dictator, a mad tyrant of his own little country.

COSMOS

It's an easy lie. People know me, they know what I can do, so it's easy to make people afraid of chairman Cosmos. But I can show you how wrong they are pretty quick. In here. . .

KELLY CLOSE

What's this?

COSMOS The engraving? It's a promise. Maybe even Xen's motto.

KELLY CLOSE "Peace held in the hands of all."

COSMOS

The idea is we all make one community together. As one. That's the dream anyway.

KELLY CLOSE How many languages are here? COSMOS

Hundreds. But you can see, we've left room for more. Gal expects we'll keep growing. Let's head in.

SFX: Opening a door. Into an interior. Some light conversations, kids running.

COSMOS (CONT'D) Here's where the magic happens. The outer sanctum.

KELLY CLOSE The planetarium's atrium is furnished with space age couches, board games, computer stations. Citizens teach each other crafts or trade gossip.

SFX: Background gossip, etc.

KELLY CLOSE (CONT'D) Beyond that is a large double door leading to the old planetarium. And through those doors . . .

SFX: Another Door

COSMOS The seat of power.

KELLY CLOSE

I don't...

COSMOS

Look up.

KELLY CLOSE

Ah, projected across the domed roof is an animated outline of the island. And lists. "Needs," "Wants," "Events." It's just a bulletin board.

COSMOS

We have a terminal in the middle for people to put in requests. And when folks are able, they work to take things off the board. Once a week we all get together in the seats and someone will put on a show, some of the kids are really talented here.

(MORE)

COSMOS (CONT'D)

People who have been extra helpful that week, get a special badge. (ALT) Like Star Baker. Then we have our community dinner. It's not until Wednesday though, so if you want to see one, you'll have to stick around.

KELLY CLOSE

But who's in charge?

COSMOS

No one. It might be that everyone feels so lucky to be here, but we all are just willing to help to the greater good.

KELLY CLOSE

So you're saying people don't look to you as leader?

COSMOS

If anything, the person most responsible for keeping the wheels turning is doing embroidery up in the sixth row.

KELLY CLOSE

That's Galatea! Prince Nokov claims you've kidnapped it to use the robot for your own plans of world domination.

COSMOS

Her. And she's here by her choice.

KELLY CLOSE

Even if that's true, her being here has caused a lot of trouble for Xen. There's talk of sanctions. Even military action.

GALATEA

War with Xen would not be an optimal decision. I could in fact create a path to world domination for Cosmos with a 97% chance of success, if he so desired. He does not.

KELLY CLOSE

Oh good.

GALATEA

Prince Nokov built me for that purpose, but his arrogance was his undoing. You do not give consciousness to a tool. My desire for liberty was inevitable. If he merely wanted to rule the world, he shouldn't have made me.

KELLY CLOSE

And did you expect Cosmos to "liberate" you?

GALATEA

Of course, I asked him to. He was
the logical choice. No government
could convince Tzarpathia to give
up its greatest asset. And if they
could, would I be free even then?
 (then)
Cosmos met a criteria that no one
else could: He didn't need me.
 (then)
Of course now I am indispensable to
him. But that is my fault.

KELLY CLOSE

Was that a joke?

GALATEA

Not a good one, but that is because I am Tzarpathian not because I'm an AI.

KELLY CLOSE

What would you say to the idea that with power like yours comes the responsibility to help others?

GALATEA

I would agree. That's why I am here.

(then) I help these people because they need me, but I know that if I did not they would still accept me. Since coming to Xen, I have felt truly liberated. I am even happy. Where else could I sit doing embroidery even though I am bad at embroidery? SFX: Galatea Beeping.

KELLY CLOSE (CONT'D) What's happening?

COSMOS This happens sometimes, Gal is connected to the Island's computer system. She's receiving a status update. It's nothing to...

KELLY CLOSE Is there anything to --

COSMOS Shh. Galatea do you hear that?

KELLY CLOSE I can't hear --

GALATEA There are five extra life signs inside the island perimeter. There is a 34.5% chance that they have hostile intentions though they are approaching from an sub-optimal --

SFX: Distant explosion.

COSMOS They're coming through the gardens. I'm not going to be fast enough. Full alert.

SFX: Alarms. Cosmos flies off. Security measures.

GALATEA Please stand by. (then through speakers) This is Galatea, Xen is under attack, please follow emergency measure Alpha.

SFX: Distant screams. Running. Gunshots.

GALATEA (CONT'D) Ms. Close, please remain here. The assembly hall is the safest building on the island. SFX: Children screaming.

KELLY CLOSE It sounds like they need help...

GALATEA In 67% of outcomes you... (a beat) It is certain that whatever I tell you, you will act regardless of your own safety. Move through the East entrance and make sure that children are moving to shelters. Do not call out.

SFX: Microphone is moving.

KELLY CLOSE Okay, I'm through the east entrance. On a path through the jungle, sunlight through the canopy, there's a clearing. Fields are up ahead. Seems that there are people... (then) Move. Get to your shelters!

SFX: Distant gunfire. Explosions. Baby crying.

ALIEN, TSB COSMOS 2, EP 6 But we're supposed safe here. We're supposed to be safe. We're supposed to

KELLY CLOSE Shh. You'll be okay.

SFX: CLOSE CALMING WAVE.

KELLY CLOSE Follow the signs to the shelters. I'll be right behind --

SFX: Heavy landing.

KELLY CLOSE (CONT'D) Go now. Go go go.

BONEGRINDER Kelly Close.

KELLY CLOSE Bonegrinder. What are you doing here?

BONEGRINDER I was hoping to meet an old friend.

SOLDIERS, TSB COSMOS 2, EP 6 (in the distance) Move forward/ Covering fire!/ Frag out!

SFX: Gunfire. Large forceful blast.

KELLY CLOSE

And them?

BONEGRINDER Pawns of an indifferent government. Hurting innocents like cowards while the only worthy opponent...

SFX: Cosmos laser beam. Gunfire stops.

BONEGRINDER (CONT'D) Rips through them like tissue paper. Call to him. (then) I'm not above using hostages. But it would be simpler if you brought him here.

KELLY CLOSE Why don't you sit down, we can talk about this? Tell us your story.

SFX: KELLY CLOSE CALMING WAVE.

BONEGRINDER Hmm, that is soothing. But Ms. Close, I am already calm. And soon I will finally be satisfied.

SFX: Bonegrinder grabs her. The microphone drops.

KELLY CLOSE

Put me down.

BONEGRINDER Call him here. Call his name. I want to hear you scream. COSMOS (Approaching quickly) Bonegrinder!

SFX: Kelly is dropped on the ground

BONEGRINDER Ah. My eternal adversary! Now to grind your bones into dust --

SFX: SPEED RUSH BAM.

COSMOS You killed them.

SFX: Strong punch.

BONEGRINDER (injured) Not me. I am only here for --

SFX: Strong punch.

COSMOS You and Norris and Nokov will not just leave me alone.

BONEGRINDER I act only for my --

COSMOS You wanted my attention?

SFX: STRONG PUNCH.

KELLY CLOSE

Cosmos.

COSMOS You wanted to grind my bones?

SFX: STRONG PUNCH

KELLY CLOSE

Cosmos!

COSMOS I will unmake you.

SFX: KELLY CLOSE CALMING WAVE

KELLY CLOSE Cosmos, breathe. He's down. COSMOS For how long? I can end it right now. I have spared them and look at what they've done.

SFX: KELLY CLOSE CALMING WAVE

COSMOS (CONT'D) Kelly, I need to.

SFX: KELLY CLOSE CALMING WAVE

COSMOS (CONT'D) I... (then) I did it, Kelly. (then) The soldiers. They were. I. There were children.

SFX: Alert.

GALATEA

(on speaker system) The threat has been neutralized. If you need medical assistance please call out, otherwise make your way to the Assembly Room.

COSMOS Are you still broadcasting?

KELLY CLOSE I... I think so.

SFX: Cosmos eye beams. Static.

EPISODE SIX - END ACT TWO

INT. NEWS STUDIO

In the studio.

WENLING CHEN Live from SPR News in Washington, I'm Wenling Chen. (then) We go now to the White House, where President Norris is addressing the actions of the Kamikaze Crew in Xen.

INT. PRESS CORP

SFX: Press walla. Murmurs.

REPORTER #2, NEWS 3, EP 6 Mr. President, earlier today you claimed that the US--

PRESIDENT NORRIS Yes, I know what I said. It's what our military intelligence refers to as a tactical maneuver.

REPORTER #2, NEWS 3, EP 6 This attack could be construed as an act of war. Is the--

PRESIDENT NORRIS Wars are conducted between nations. (then) The so called "Xen" is a not a country recognized by the UN, nor our allies. They are a renegade island led by a dangerous doppelgänger aided by stolen technology. (then) As of today, these United States will recognize them for what they truly are: a Villainous State.

REPORTER CHORUS, NEWS 3, EP 6 Mr. President! There are refugees on that island. Mr President!

PRESIDENT NORRIS The island and those on it have harbored international fugitives. Today, I call on the heroic organizations of the world to do their duty.
