(then)

Following a These American Supers report on the Legion's role in Supervillain escapes, Superheroes have staged a nationwide walkout from Legion facilities. These heroes have demanded that Iron Barracuda be replaced as Legion Leader, and that the company end its support of the Super Act.

(then)
We will update you as this story develops.

UNDERWRITER

That was Wenling Chen reporting from Washington, it's 75 degrees here in Paradise City. And now for The Utility Belt.

#### EPISODE NINE - ACT ONE - UB RADIOACTIVE BLOOD

INT. UB STUDIO 11

In the studio.

STAN

Live, around the world, from Goat Man's Cliffs of Sorrow to your Uncle Mike's man-cave of depression, it's the Utility Belt. (then)

I'm Stan the Henchman, with me is the hundred-pound kid with the twohundred-point IQ, the Master of Math himself, it's Billy, the Whiz Kid.

WHIZ KID

Thanks, Stan. You've really got my number.

(beat)

Get it? Math? Numbers?

STAN

Listen kid, the reviews are in. Our listeners say your jokes don't add up.

WHIZ KID

A few folks may find them divisive, but what about the remainder?

STAN

Afraid not liking math puns is the common denominator.

WHIZ KID

But no one's pun game is as good as minus. I have no equal. I'm in my prime.

(then)

You know what, forget the show, we could just do this all day.

PRODUCER BOT

You have fifteen emergency calls.

STAN

Day off sounds nice.

PRODUCER BOT

You have fourteen emergency calls.

WHIZ KID

Okay okay, let's start the show.

STAN

We've got Jeff from Toronto, Canada.

WHIZ KID

What's your major malfunction?

**JEFF** 

(Jeff Goldblum)

Hi, Stan. Hi, Billy. Long time listener, uh, first time caller here.

SFX: Buzzing insect sound.

STAN

I recognize that voice! My old colleague, Jeff Silverton! What's the buzz, Jeff?

**JEFF** 

Uh. Um. Okay, here goes. I'm a genome sequencer for a research program that is working to create super intelligent mosquitos-

WHIZ KID

Mosquitos already kill over a million people a year. You took the deadliest creature on the planet and made them worse?

STAN

Jeff's always been a go getter. Reminds me of our days on the island of Professor Crispr.

WHIZ KID

The island where they made all those half-human half-dinosaurs?

**JEFF** 

We were so preoccupied by whether we could turn people into dinosaurs that we never stopped to think about why anyone would want us to.

STAN

Good money though.

**JEFF** 

Oh yes, mmm.

STAN

So Jeff, you must have been getting swamped by offers, why mosquitos?

**JEFF** 

Well, I have a rare blood disorder.

STAN

How rare?

JEFF

It's called Jeff Silverton disease.

WHIZ KID

Yikes.

**JEFF** 

But I've been working on a cure. The mutated Cas9 proteins in these insects reached balanced morbosity, they've evolved beyond my wildest predictions.

(then)

Until one of the smartest ones escaped its cage and bit me. A total breach of trust.

STAN

Okay, my friend. Don't worry I'm an expert. Years in Croc Command's Summer Swamp.

(then)

What you do is you go to a pharmacy and get calamine lotion, c-a-l-a-m-i-n-e.

**JEFF** 

I'm, uh, afraid that, more interesting, worse, frightening things are happening.

WHIZ KID

Worse than itching? After being bit by a mutant bug in a medical research lab? No way.

Uh no. See, uh, the problem is, ever since I got bit, I've been, changing. I need less sleep and my sense of smell is amazing. I can guess your blood type from across the street.

WHIZ KID

That actually sounds kind of cool!

STAN

Do you have a six-pack?

WHIZ KID

Why would he? Mosquito's don't--

**JEFF** 

Actually yes, I look like a GQ model.

STAN

I'm not sensing any real drawbacks here.

**JEFF** 

Well, I'm suddenly drawn to stagnant water, and I've got an extra set of legs coming in.

(then)

Oh, and I'm starting to wonder what my lab partner tastes like.

STAN

Insomnia, extra limbs, bloodlust.
Who are you, my ex wife?

WHIZ KID

Hey Stan, the 1980s called, they want their lazy bad marriage jokes back.

STAN

Who's joking?

(adding)

Esmeralda, if you're listening, we'll find a cure.

WHIZ KID

-- OK, back to Jeff's problem. Jeff, I gotta ask, limbs vestigial or functional?

Oh they are functional, but they seem to have a mind of their own.

STAN

Just like Esmeralda.

**JEFF** 

Um, so, every time I fall asleep, The legs sleep-walk.

(then)

Today I woke up inside a blood bank, empty bags of A and B positive scattered around my feet, but what really scares me is I was craving something headier and more sophisticated, like a dark, rich O negative.

STAN

I prefer a nice Rosé myself.

**JEFF** 

Please, Stan, you know me, I'm not a bad guy, I'm trying to find a cure, not play god.

WHIZ KID

And how did that work out for you on Dinosaur Island?

SFX: Buzzing. Gross mutation sounds.

**JEFF** 

It's getting worse! What are these things growing out of my back?

STAN

Things seem to be progressing quickly, we'll have to think fast. What have you already tried?

**JEFF** 

Well, I tried lighting one of those citronella candles, but it made me just

(sexy? angry mosquito sound)

Rawr. Hated it.

STAN

You have three phds. You perfected domestic teleportation.

It's possible that as I'm getting sexier and more monstrous I'm also getting a little dumber. A little more fierce. Grr.

WHIZ KID

Wait, do you have a teleporter in the lab?

**JEFF** 

Guilty, I hate commuting, but I love suburbia.

WHIZ KID

Teleporters work by breaking down your genetic sequence in one place and rebuilding it in an other. Well made ones have a failsafe designed to keep different DNA separate, so if an animal got in there with you, it wouldn't mix you up.

STAN

So if you got a hold of the mosquito that bit you, maybe you can use the transporter to separate your blended gene sequences! Hey, that's not a bad plan!

WHIZ KID

Is the bug still in the lab?

**JEFF** 

Oh yes. I've had it in a little glass jar in the pocket of my second pair of pants.

WHIZ KID

You have two pairs of pants?

**JEFF** 

One no longer can contain me.

WHIZ KID

Well if you need more coverage, you can always splice your jeans. Get it? Like, "genes."

(then)

Where's the teleporter?

It's upstairs. But I share the space with some drug cartel, and I'm getting thirsty if you know what I mean.

WHIZ KID

Do those wings work?

SFX: Shattering glass.

**JEFF** 

(whispers)

Oh yes.

STAN

The direct approach. The human fly.

**JEFF** 

Mosquito.

STAN

Whatever.

**JEFF** 

I'm there.

SFX Shattering glass.

WHIZ KID

Do those not open?

**JEFF** 

This is a genius idea, brilliant. Using one of my great ideas to undo one of my terrible ideas. Setting in my destination.

SFX: Beeps and boops.

JEFF (CONT'D)

Okay, got it. The teleporter will just send me back downstairs and the mosquito ... can get sent right back to hell.

SFX: Door creak and slam.

NOTE: All of Jeff's dialogue inside the teleporter should has a slight echo.

WHIZ KID

Well be careful with that, remember the mosquito needs to be alive or it won't work.

STAN

You have it safe?

**JEFF** 

Yes, still here in my pocket.

SFX: Small tinkle of glass.

JEFF (CONT'D)

Oh oh no. It's out. Hmm. Saucy boy, back for more? Sorry but the kitchen is closed.

SFX: Mosquito buzzing. Jeff buzzing back.

STAN

Easy Jeff as long as it's in the chamber ...

SFX: Slap.

STAN (CONT'D)

Tell me that was you giving yourself a high five.

**JEFF** 

Ah unfortunately no. Hmm. That's five years of research smeared on my neck.

WHIZ KID

That's OK as long as you can get out of the machine everything is going to be fine.

(then)

These things usually have a countdown so --

TELEPORTER

Teleporter activating right now.

WHIZ KID

STAN

Oh wait.

Oh boy.

SFX: Teleportation noises.

STAN (CONT'D)

Wow, that is unfortunate.

WHIZ KID

Maybe everything is going to be ok.

SFX: Door creaking open.

STAN

Jeff are you there?

SFX: Growling. A moment later another distant door opens. Then a light switch turns on.

CARTEL GUARD UB FLY

Hey, who is in here? This Canadian Meth lab is closed.

SFX: Big footsteps coming out of the machine.

CARTEL GUARD UB FLY (CONT'D)

Ey, visiting hours are until 8. I will get rough with you.

**JEFF** 

(monster voice)

Is that type-O negative blood I smell?

CARTEL GUARD UB FLY

No! Get away from me! (screams)

My blood!

SFX: Phone clatters and goes dead.

STAN

Sounds like Jeff found a universal donor.

PRODUCER BOT

Call terminated.

WHIZ KID

Did we just watch the creation of a new supervillain?

STAN

He killed a hired gun for a meth lab, so I think that makes him a compelling anti-hero.

WHIZ KID

I'd watch his story in theaters for sure. Definitely. 100% would see it. Maybe twice.

STAN

Really?

WHIZ KID

No.

STAN

Well that sucked up all of our time.

WHIZ KID

As always, if you have tech questions, we've got answers.

STAN

Give us a call at 414-555-BELT. That's 414-555-BELT.

(then)

I am Stan the Henchman.

WHIZ KID

I'm Billy the Whiz Kid.

WHIZ-KID

Belt!

And this was The Utility And this was The Utility

Belt!

# EPISODE NINE - END ACT ONE

## EPISODE NINE - NEWS TWO - TCAS PT. 2

INT. AD BREAK

In the studio.

ADS

Support for SPR comes from...

(then)

Soul Secure.

(then)

We're all afraid of identity theft, but what about when your sense of identity is erased? That's why we founded Soul Secure. A state of the art mind duplication service.

(DO A VERSION WITH THIS)
In case your mind is wiped by
science or magic, Soul Secure's
patented identity backup uploads
directly into your empty brain
matter. It'll be as if nothing ever
happened.

(then)

This copy is a perfect replica of your consciousness. And while you may wonder what the self is and whether this new version is the authentic you and what is life and death, what is the soul...don't.

(then, a longer beat)

Soul Secure.

(adding)

Don't worry about id.

INT. NEWS STUDIO

In the studio.

WENLING CHEN

Live from SPR News in Washington, I'm Wenling Chen.

(then)

Across the country people have reported seeing a masked figure claiming to be the hero Quantum. The hero's own daughter, and SPR Reporter, Apoorva Singh is on the case with part two of our investigative segment: "To Catch a Speedster."

APOORVA SINGH

Yesterday, in Raleigh North Carolina, NormCore held a Normalize America rally before the event was interrupted in a flash of purple light.

(then)

One of the attendees, SheepDog26, recorded this footage.

Note: The following segment is all cell phone quality. Gary's speech is through the stadium speakers.

GARY

-- And we declare that honest flesh and blood Americans still have a place in this society.

SFX: Crowd cheers.

GARY (CONT'D)

Our stories will not be erased by these genetic --

SFX: Quantum Speedster Zip. Chaos. Yelps. Ground Tearing. Wind. Thuds.

GARY (CONT'D)

NORM-guard!

SFX: Guns being cocked. Quantum Speedster Zip. Sounds of guns being moved.

VARIOUS NORM-GUARD

Hey my gun / Give that back / What happened / Bwah?

QUANTUM

(into the mic)

Stand down. Disband. Or you'll be next! (ALT: Supers are not your enemy. Fascist punks like these are. Go home and make better choices.)

SFX: Quantum Speedster Zip.

APOORVA SINGH

Fairgrounds Manager Jim Pratchett witnessed the event first-hand.

JIM

Yeah, it was crazy. Like, I don't consider myself one of those antisuper guys, but I think them
NormCore fellows have some interesting points, no offense.

(then)

So, I stayed to watch. Then, right in the middle of the speech your daddy --

APOORVA SINGH

-- So he claims.

JIM

Sure, no offense, that fella blew through and rained hot havoc on them.

(then)

Everyone ended up in a pile on top of the Wonder Tower, really inconsiderate to the staff, no offense.

(then)

Whole day of getting that mess sorted. Not to mention cleaning up all the fliers Quantum left for that Incognito terrorist group, no offense.

(then)

Though, I think that Gary fella is kind of a fat-head so I didn't mind seeing him tied up like that.

APOORVA SINGH

Did you see the Quantum Imposter?

JIM

Sure I saw Quantum, zipping around at top speed. A big ol purple blur.

APOORVA SINGH

Never stopped?

JIM

Not a once.

APOORVA SINGH

So, being a speedster myself, I want to demonstrate two discrepancies that are captured by this video.

(Mic shuffling. Off axis.) Jim, can you hold this?

Note:

JIM

(Off axis)

No problem Ms. Singh.

APOORVA SINGH

First, the stage meets by a dirt lot. When you run in circles like that.

SFX: Apoorva Speedster Zip. Jim starts coughing.

APOORVA SINGH (CONT'D) There's going to be a lot of dust.

We don't see that in the video. Did you?

JIM

No. Woulda remembered that.

APOORVA SINGH

The second, we hear Quantum asking people to stand down. And it sounded like Quantum to you?

JIM

Well. I don't mean no --

APOORVA SINGH

-- Offense, right. But it sounded normal?

JIM

I mean yeah. Just like him. Pretty much just like that: "Smell me later" ad.

APOORVA SINGH

While he was running?

JIM

Yeah, came booming out of the purple tornado.

APOORVA SINGH

You've heard of the Doppler Effect, Jim?

JIM

Like with weather?

APOORVA SINGH

Sure. See, when you're traveling at top speed the sound your voice makes --

SFX: Apoorva speedster zip. Apoorva's next bit of dialogue is speed up due to her speed.

APOORVA SINGH (CONT'D)

-- Will get warped by the Doppler Effect.

Note: Back to normal.

APOORVA SINGH (CONT'D)

You catch that?

JIM

What?

APOORVA SINGH

All that sound gets compressed into a screech.

MTU

Huh. You can see him though.

APOORVA SINGH

Quantum at full speed is basically invisible.

JIM

Huh, well he must be standing still because ain't that him on top of the tilt-o-whig over there?

APOORVA SINGH

Stop right there!

SFX: Apoorva speedster zip. Quantum speedster zip. Chase. Ambience changes. Zipping.

APOORVA SINGH (CONT'D)

(out of breath)

Who are you?

QUANTUM

I know this is a surprise.

SFX: ZIP ZIP

APOORVA SINGH

Who. Are. You.

QUANTUM

It's me, Rabbit.

APOORVA SINGH

Don't call me that. I was there. He died.

**QUANTUM** 

I promise I will explain. But for now, let me work. Someone needs to stand up to these bullies.

APOORVA SINGH

Good do it, but don't hide behind my father's face.

QUANTUM

Rabbit--

APOORVA SINGH

Don't.

SFX: ZIP ZIP

QUANTUM

It's like I always told you. A hero's just the person who shows up when they're needed.

APOORVA SINGH

Why?

**QUANTUM** 

I am so proud of you. But let me work.

APOORVA SINGH

You are not my father.

QUANTUM

...You'll have to catch me to prove it.

SFX: Quantum speedster zip.

SFX: Apoorva speedster zip. Trip. BOOM.

WENLING CHEN

... Apoorva? Apoorva?

APOORVA SINGH

Ah, he tied my shoelaces. I lost him. But I'll get him next time. I promise.

# UNDERWRITER

That was Apoorva Singh reporting from Raleigh. It's 74 degrees here in Paradise City. And now 100% Invisible.

# EPISODE NINE - END NEWS TWO

#### EPISODE NINE - ACT TWO - 1001 "GIVING TREE"

INT. 100I STUDIO - DAY

In the studio.

ARES GRECO

This is 100% Invisible, I'm Ares Greco.

SFX: Birds. Bright music. Sunshine.

ARES GRECO (CONT'D)

"If you must take, take of me, and mark this spot as where the world's axes fell."

(then)

These are the words etched on a small brass plaque on the gates of the World Tree.

(then)

Planted by The Green Thumb using the power of Gaia, the World Tree was designed to save Mother Nature from the demands of a growing population.

(then)

At full bloom it can provide almost a third of the world's hardwood needs, as well as twenty percent of its fresh fruit supply.

(then)

It grows 300 feet tall and 200 feet wide, blooming in purples, blues, and oranges, commanding the horizon.

(then)

Simply put it's...

CHAD TREE

An eyesore! I mean look at the thing. It's a total --

KAREN TREE

Nightmare of sirens and horns, every day, not to mention the --

KEVIN BUFFANT

Birds! Thousands of squawking birds every blessed day!

SFX: Bird squawking

ARES GRECO

You would think a tree the size of a skyscraper would be at home in one of America's many natural forests, but instead it sprouted just outside of Hastings, Nebraska. (then)

The tree was intended to be a gift to the entire world, but many of the locals have taken a different view.

(then)

This is Kevin Buffant who has been leading the charge.

KEVIN BUFFANT

We call ourselves the UPset Residents Ordering Out the Tree. Get it?.

ARES GRECO

I get it.

KEVIN BUFFANT Uproot. It spells uproot.

ARES GRECO

Sure. I get that it's been
disruptive, but this tree, is a --

KEVIN BUFFANT

It's a gift! We know. We hear that often enough

(pfft)

Must seem that way if you don't have to live with it. But to us this thing is a fruit cake at Christmas.

ARES GRECO

I actually quite like fruit cake.

KEVIN BUFFANT

Good for you.

(then)

It's not like we don't understand it's a big deal. I'm sure the tree is great for mother nature, but we have mothers in our community who are suffering! Imagine hearing a tree the size of the Lighthouse of Freedom getting cut down every day. (then)

(MORE)

KEVIN BUFFANT (CONT'D)

Then there's the trucks driving in and out, never stops, and then the birds, 10,000 of the pests flying overhead morning and night.

(then)

You park outside and your car's getting painted white if you know what I mean.

ARES GRECO

I get it.

KEVIN BUFFANT

Poop, Ares. Bird poop. (then)

We can't even wash our cars because of water conservation. For the tree. It's a nightmare.

SFX: Getting out of a car.

ARES GRECO

This community organization has had plenty of help from large corporate backers providing UPROOT with money for radio ads and billboards and rallies. On the other side, The World Tree Trust recruits volunteers like super Environmentalist Fern Potter who have been working to keep the tree in place.

(then)

I met Fern at the perimeter fence of the mega flora.

FERN

Whenever the environment gets ahead somewhere, there's usually a pretty strong pushback. This tree is no different.

SFX: Tree Walla. Birds.

ARES GRECO

People didn't like a perfect tree with fresh, perfect fruit and an unlimited supply of perfect wood?

FERN

Fruit companies didn't. Lumber companies didn't either.

(then)

(MORE)

FERN (CONT'D)

Green Thumb set up a trust before he planted it to sell the fruit and lumber at cost.

(then)

The tree single handedly disrupted two of the largest industries in the country.

(then)

So yeah, the protest groups have pretty deep pockets.

(then)

Let's get closer.

SFX: Driving.

ARES GRECO

How long does the lumber convoy go?

FERN

Miles. Every time they cut down a branch a new one sprouts in its place.

SFX: Truck honk.

FERN (CONT'D)

(disappointed)

Those should be electric.

ARES GRECO

Where are we now?

FERN

This is supply road L.

(then)

There's 22 roads in total and this is the least busy. We've proposed creating electric train lines in and out, but there never seems to be money for infrastructure. Plenty of money for more trucks though.

(then)

The government thinks this place is a bit of a money pit.

ARES GRECO

Ts it?

FERN

It's priceless. Not free.

ARES GRECO (ASIDE)

As we drove down the supply road we came to the top of the hill and already you could see the canopy of the World Tree reaching up to the morning sun. It was misty, casting a long shadow on Hastings below it. An army of harvesters stretched below it.

(then, live)

This must be a weird sight for you.

FERN

Better here than the Amazon. That was the point.

(then)

You ever been here before?

ARES GRECO

No, it's my first time. I never expected the...

FERN

Deafening metal scraping of industry?

ARES GRECO

Yeah.

(then)

According to the Forestry service, from Tuesday to Saturday, there are 27,000 people working to process the World Tree.

(then)

In the morning, fruit is gathered and sorted. Every piece is grown perfectly without pesticides, so inspections are light. Then in the afternoon.

SFX: Loud crash. Birds in flight.

ARES GRECO (CONT'D)

By the pantheon!

SFX: Crackling energy.

FERN

Just the start of the logging.

SFX: Loud distant sounds of industry.

ARES GRECO

We must still be a mile away.

FERN

It's a third of our lumber supply coming in at once. Did you know that this tree has slowed deforestation by thirty years?

ARES GRECO

Wow.

(then)

Still I understand some of the complaints.

FERN

That's the Not in My Backyard crowd.

(then)

Not to sound cold, but the handful of property owners hardly balance out the millions of people who are fed by this tree. Thousands of forests and ecosystems preserved, species saved from extinction. But corporate PR teams love making these mildly inconvenienced homeowners out to be victims. Timber.

SFX: Crackling, another boom.

Music cue: Hopeful.

ARES GRECO (STUDIO) From our vantage we could see the perfect dance of titanic fellers bringing the tree down in an cleared outline two football fields long. Smaller vehicles descend on it like ants.

(then)

We watched for hours as the tree was disassembled, day fading into the night as it came down. Already the World Tree was growing back whole from its stump.

FERN

Humans consume, that's part of life, but in the last hundred years, we have taken more than we've given back. This tree was meant to tilt the scales back in Earth's favor.

ARES GRECO

Has it worked?

FERN

It's helped. But someone always finds a cheaper, more destructive option and capitalism doesn't figure in the value of a pristine wilderness. Look at all the champions of nature who are locked up, labeled villains and rogues. All because they prize life more than money. Someday they'll come for this miracle too. Some corporation will buy the rights to uproot this tree and it'll die. Or maybe they'll leave it as is, shut down the harvesting and get their lumber from where it can net them more profit.

ARES GRECO

That's a fairly dismal take.

FERN

Well, the good news is that's not the end of it.

(then)

In the end, after all the leaves have fallen, Nature always wins. It's just a question of whether humanity loses. That's the full truth.

SFX: Tree creaking. Falling.

ARES GRECO (STUDIO)

Fern Potter works with the nonprofit Saving the Earth providing education and resources for creating new environmental heroes.

(then)

From 100% invisible. I'm Ares Greco. Tune in next time for more stories of design.

### EPISODE NINE - NEWS THREE

INT. NEWS STUDIO

In the studio.

WENLING CHEN

-- Breaking News, Heroic Legion Tower Two has been taken over by members of NormCore. We go live to Ben Beltzer on the scene in Seattle.

(then)

Ben?

EXT. TOWER

SFX: Rioting. Police.

BEN BELTZER

Thanks Wenling.

(then)

I've never seen anything like this in my life.

(then)

Tower Two had been completely abandoned during the organized walkouts this afternoon. The protesting heroes merely watched their headquarters become overrun by NormCore forces.

WENLING CHEN

Can you get a statement from any of the heroes on the scene?

BEN BELTZER

One second.

(moving)

Hi SPR News, what can you tell me about the takeover of Tower Two?

BLUE BELLE

They stormed in about a half hour ago, guns a-blazing.

(fart noises)

Our orders are to stand by. So that's what we're doing.

#### BEN BELTZER

And what about the police? Have they made any moves to arrest the invaders?

BLUE BELLE

Oh you can see them over there, taking selfies with them.

SFX: Camera snap.

POLICE OFFICER

(in the distance)

Ok now lets do a fun one.

BLUE BELLE

Honestly I think they're waiting on the same thing we're waiting on.

BEN BELTZER

Which is?

BLUE BELLE

Washington.

(then)

Soon as these assholes are declared villainous we can do something about it, until then, they can have the building. Maybe that'll wake people up.

BEN BELTZER

The official flag of the Legion of has been lowered and in its place, the fluffy white sheep of Norm-core.

GARY

(over loud speaker)

Normcore, the building is ours. The future belongs to the sheep!

NORMCORE CHORUS, NEWS 3, EP 9

Baaaaaa!

BEN BELTZER

And there you have it.

UNDERWRITER

That was Ben Beltzer reporting from Seattle.

(then)

(MORE)
